



Backlog Management Workshop

Abstract

When moving from a traditional project management methodology to Agile, one of the big changes is the way requirements are handled. This workshop teaches the basics to Agile requirements handling and Agile backlog management. The workshop is divided into two parts: part one - which takes up most of the time - provides the knowledge needed to write good and effective Agile requirements. The second part is a facilitated requirement workshop, based on real materials of the group. **Participants are encouraged to bring to the workshop high level requirements from their world, or an idea for a project that they would like to start implementing using Agile.**
